Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Closure of: Pink Lane, Charlton (Ref: TTRO 6718)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

- A. Pink Lane (Part), Charlton; from its junction with Brickyard Hill for a distance of approximately 1.90 kilometres in an easterly direction;
- B. Pink Lane (Part), Charlton from its junction with Sundays Hill for a distance of approximately 60 metres in a northerly direction;
- C. Pink Lane (Part), Charlton; from its junction with Eighty Acres for a distance of approximately 700 metres in a westerly direction.

To enable: Gigaclear Limited to carry out excavation works to lay cable build chamber and cabinets.

Alternative route (a) and (b): via Pink Lane (unaffected length) – Park Lane – Brickyard Hill and vice versa.

Alternative route (c): via Queen Street – Somerford Common Lane – Braydonside – Sundays Hill – Pink Lane (unaffected length) and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This Order will come into operation on 19 October 2020 and the closures will be required until 06 November 2020. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
